## Notice of Upcoming Roadworks on the N22 at Coolcour on the Cork approach to Macroom.

Jons-John Cradock JV Ltd., on behalf of Cork County Council, are constructing the N22 Baile Bhuirne to Macroom Road Development Project.

Roadworks have been ongoing on the existing N22 Cork to Macroom Road, in the Coolcour area on the Cork approach to Macroom, for a number of weeks. The current phase of works, under temporary traffic management, is due to be completed by Friday of this week, 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

The next phase of the works involving temporary traffic management on the existing N22, is scheduled to commence on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June, for a two-week period. During this time, general traffic on the N22 will be restricted to one-way flow controlled by flagmen or traffic signals, on a 24-hour basis, Monday to Friday each week, with construction works planned to take place during the full extent of daylight hours, from 6.00am to 10.30pm. No works are currently planned for these weekends. The longer working days allows us the complete these works in the shortest possible time-frame.

Significant traffic delays can be anticipated during these online works and road users are advised to use alternative routes for these periods for their Kerry to Cork and Cork to Kerry journeys.

Further updates will be issued as the works progress.

We would like to apologise for the inconvenience caused by these critical works and would like to express our appreciation to drivers using caution travelling through the works area, whilst abiding by the 50km/hr speed limit currently in force.
