**N22 Baile Bhuirne to Macroom Road Development.**

**Notice of Upcoming Roadworks on the N22 at Coolcour on the Cork approach to Macroom.**

Jons-John Cradock JV Ltd., on behalf of Cork County Council, are constructing the N22 Baile Bhuirne to Macroom Road Development Project.

Roadworks have been ongoing on the existing N22 Cork to Macroom Road, in the Coolcour area on the Cork approach to Macroom, for a number of weeks. The most recent phase of works, under 24-hour temporary traffic management, was successfully completed on Friday last, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

We are now progressing the completion of the new roundabout and the Westbound & Eastbound Link Roads to this roundabout. In order to facilitate construction of the remaining works we will be diverting Cork bound traffic onto the new Westbound Link Road, into the new roundabout, on to the Eastbound Link Road and back on to the old N22 at the Two-Mile Bridge, from this Wednesday afternoon the 13<sup>th</sup> July. Macroom bound traffic will continue on its current layout for the time being.

From the 13<sup>th</sup> July, for the next 3 to 4 weeks, we will have temporary traffic management in place with single lane flows for N22 traffic, using manned Stop/Go controls, in order to continue with the various tie-in works required in these areas. This single lane operation will be in place during working hours (7:30am to 7pm) and will revert to two-way traffic, following the new road layout, outside of these hours. Some traffic delays can be anticipated during these online works.

We would continue to ask drivers to take extra care during this upcoming phase of the works, as we transfer traffic from the current N22 to the various temporary layouts, and to abide by the 50km/hr speed limit currently in place for this work area. Road users should be aware that the final layer of road surface has not yet been laid and should proceed with care on the temporary driving surfaces as we continue to progress the works to completion.
