

## N22BBM Public Notice

### Upcoming Closure of Macroom By-Pass N22:

Jons-John Cradock JV Ltd., working on behalf of Cork County Council, is constructing the N22 Baile Bhuirne to Macroom Road Development, the first section of which opened to general traffic on 9<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2022.

Since then, work has progressed on the remainder of the scheme with the next Section as far as Tonn Láin/Baile Mhic Íre programmed to be ready for opening early in August.

Please take note that the contractor will temporarily close the new N22 Macroom By-Pass Road from 9a.m. on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> August and plan to reopen it again on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> August. This is to facilitate the safe removal of the temporary roundabout at Carrigaphoooca, west of Macroom Town, and to allow for the extension of the By-Pass as far as Tonn Láin/Baile Mhic Íre.

The alternative route for Westbound traffic during this closure will be by way of Macroom Town Centre. Eastbound traffic will be able to get on the Macroom By-Pass at the Millstreet Road.

Once the N22 reopens to traffic after this closure, road users will be able to travel westwards on the new N22 as far as Tonn Láin/Baile Mhic Íre. Similarly Eastbound traffic will be able to get on to the new N22 at Tonn Láin.

Road users are requested to drive with caution on the new N22 road once it is opens to traffic, particularly on the approach to Tonn Láin at the western end, where speed restrictions, lane narrowing and traffic signal control will be in operation to safely control traffic flow. Your co-operation with these temporary traffic control measures would be greatly appreciated by the contractor.

The contractor would like to acknowledge the co-operation and assistance received from road users during the construction phase of this project and looks forward to the completion of the project later this year.
